#### 1. Action Items

**Enrollment Process** 

Motion by Doug Young to adopt the changes to the CCCS Enrollment Information and Lottery Procedures for economically disadvantaged, twins and siblings as proposed by Executive Director and to take effect the school year of 2025/2026. Motion was seconded.

John Barry motioned to amend, pending legal review, expansion of roll-over priority status for additional groups; Coburg applicants and 4J applicants. Following board discussion, John Barry withdrew the amendment.

Board unanimously approved the motion.

Executive Director was asked to develop an updated draft of the enrollment process expanding priority roll-over status to additional priority groups; economically disadvantaged, coburg residents and 4J

residents. Exploration to include legal review and understanding the equitable nature of the process.

# 24/25 Budget Approval

Motion by Jacen Miller to approve the 2024/2025 budget as presented by Executive Director. Motion was seconded.

Motion by Doug Young to amend the budget to keep the current salary schedule. No second.

Motion to approve the 2024/2025 budget did not pass.

2 yes/5 no

Executive Director was asked to prepare three alternative, 3yr budgets.

- 1) Status Quo salary (steps remain as current, no additional steps)
- 2) Status Quo salary + 2 additional steps based on average existing year/year % increase.
- 3) 2024/2025 proposed budget salary schedule presented in Feb 26th Board meeting (includes the 2 additional steps and adjusted year/year % increase.)

Executive Director confirmed ability to provide these alternative budget scenarios to board ahead of Monday, March 4th board meeting.

#### Dress Code

Motion by Doug Young to adopt the changes to the Dress Code Purpose and Guiding Principles as proposed. Motion was seconded.
